Where can I go?


You can go to any one of the universities that joined the Coimbra Group Program in *Cancer Biology*

What about my thesis internship?


You can make arrangements with your thesis supervisor and check the possibility of an internship in a laboratory at the host university

Are these courses recognized by UniPV?



Erasmus+ for Studies

- European Union Countries
- 1 to 2 semesters
- Call: January 2026
 - > Mobility in Autumn 2026 and / or Spring 2027
- Call: June 2026
 - > Mobility in Spring 2027

Overseas Exchange Programme

- Outside Europe
- 1 semester – 5 months max
- Call: January 2026
 - > Mobility in Autumn 2026 OR Spring 2027




Erasmus+ for Studies

Overseas Exchange Programme

- List of destinations: fixed ← → International Agreements
- Fellowship: contribution to the expenses
- No University Fees
- Requirements: Regularly enrolled + Language certification

STUDY ABROAD: Language certification



- International Language certification, e.g. IELTS, DELF-DALF, TestDaf, NOT older than 3 years
 - > International language examination tests available through UNIPV Linguistic Centre - CLA.
- Language tests organized by the UNIPV Linguistic Centre, specific for the CALLS.
- Language Exemption: enrolled in a course of studies with B2 level required.

NOTE: ALWAYS CHECK THE SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS OF THE DESIRED HOST INSTITUTION!!!





TRAINEESHIP ABROAD

- All over the world, except for countries at risk
- Host institution: University, private company, NGO
- Min. 2 months, max. 12 months
- Either before OR after graduation
- Call: April 2026
 - > Mobility in the time span August 2026 – 30 September 2027
- Call: Autumn 2026 (?)
- Fellowship to support the living costs. Other external financing allowed.
- Requirement: acceptance letter from the host institution
